

The next twelve months will offer plenty of challenges to the FCC and I am seeking your vote again. I hope that my track record on the Board has shown the required level of commitment, enthusiasm and experience which is required to administer an organization such as the FCC.

As Treasurer, working alongside a very capable Finance Committee and Accounts team, we have been able to keep prices and costs steady for the past year without depleting the Club's reserves that it is only prudent to maintain. The next twelve months will see us needing to implement changes which will see the long term future and sustainability of the FCC well beyond my time, with initiatives such as this year's review of Silver Membership being just one area where we have to face reality.

Whilst we are first and foremost a media Club, we are a business with a significant turnover and a large staff. The Associate members play a vital in allowing the FCC to continue needs to be recognized by strong representation on the Board, with a keen eye on fiscal discipline. That is what I have endeavored to do over the past three years and wish to continue for a further term.

I am a strong supporter of initiatives which raise the profile of the FCC in the broader community. I have tried to make the FCC Ball more affordable for rank and file members through a restructuring of ticket prices (so far unsuccessfully) and I have also actively supported the Human Rights Press Awards to put it on a secure financial footing so that this event can develop further. Both the charity ball and the HRPAs are important parts of Club life, but it is vital that they involve the broader membership and do not become personal vanity projects.

As I said last year, I have no agenda other than the long term health of the FCC. I hope I can rely on your support.
