

In addition to his day job, Tim is the Chairman of the Hong Kong Port Welfare Committee, which oversees the raising and distribution of funds to organizations such as the Missions to Seafarers and is also a Director of the Half The Sky Foundation, a charitable organization which in partnership with the Chinese government provides life changing care and a second chance in life to orphans in over sixty Child Welfare Institutions across China.

As well as providing correspondent members with ready access to international shipping markets, Tim is an occasional journalist to various shipping publications and also has a range of business interests in motor racing.

Of the FCC, which he joined as an Associate in 1998, he says: “It’s a home from home and the source of numerous friendships and plenty of lively banter.
