I covered the rise of the middle class in China and the 2008 Olympic Games, the Sichuan earthquake of the same year and the riots in Xinjiang in 2009. In 2014 I moved to the Sydney AFP bureau and after 6 years moved back to Hong Kong. I have won numerous awards including the Human Rights press awards, twice. I am British of English and Welsh stock, born in Bedford in the home counties.
