Non-Civil Service Vacancy

Assistant Multimedia Reporter (English News and Current Affairs Section, Radio Division)
(Salary: \$18,840 - \$22,560 per month, depending on experience)

Entry Requirements: Candidates should have -

- (a) (i) a Hong Kong Bachelor's degree, preferably in Journalism & Communications, or equivalent; OR
- (ii) an accredited associate degree or an accredited higher diploma, preferably in Journalism & Communications, from a Hong Kong tertiary institution, or equivalent; and at least 1 year's experience in Radio or TV broadcasting, journalism or related fields; AND
- (b) met the language proficiency requirement of Level 3 or above in English Language in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination (HKDSEE) / Hong Kong Certificate of Education Examination (HKCEE), or equivalent [See Note (1)].

Candidates who possess -

- (i) good broadcasting voice;
- (ii) sound knowledge of public and current affairs;
- (iii) the obtainment of Level 3 or above in Chinese Language in the HKCEE/HKDSEE, or equivalent [See Note (1)];
- (iv) fluency in Putonghua; and
- (v) skills in undertaking web publishing work, including handling text, photo, sound, video and social media

will have an advantage.

[Note: (1) "Grade C" in Chinese Language and English Language (Syllabus B) in previous HKCEE are accepted administratively as comparable to "Level 3" in Chinese Language and English Language in the 2007 HKCEE and henceforth. (2) Candidates may be required to sit for a trade test and / or voice test.]

Duties: Performing various editorial duties including reporting and internet publishing. Other duties may include editing copy and audiovisual material; programme preparation / production; and ensuring the content of news bulletins and news-related programmes is accurate, balanced and of good standard. (Note: Required to work irregular hours / over-night shifts / weekends.)

Terms of Appointment & Fringe Benefits: Successful candidate will be appointed on one-year non-civil service contract terms. If the contract is satisfactorily completed with consistently high standard of performance and conduct, the officer may be granted a gratuity which, when added together with the Government's contribution to MPF scheme, equals 15% of the total basic salary drawn during the contract period. Rest days, general holidays, annual leave, maternity leave, paternity leave, sickness allowance, where appropriate, will be granted on terms not less favourable than the provisions of the Employment Ordinance.

An applicant will bear any consequences arising from not paying sufficient postage. The postmark date on the envelope will be regarded as the date of submission of application. Applications which are late, incomplete, submitted by fax or by e-mail or not made in the prescribed form will NOT be considered. Candidates who are selected for interview will normally receive an invitation in about 6 weeks from the closing date for application. Those who are not invited for interview may assume that their applications are unsuccessful. Only shortlisted candidates will be notified.

General Notes:

- (A) Candidates must be permanent residents of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region at the time of appointment unless specified otherwise.
- (B) As an Equal Opportunities Employer, the Government is committed to eliminating discrimination in employment. The vacancy advertised is open to all applicants meeting the basic entry requirements irrespective of their disability, sex, marital status, pregnancy, age, family status, sexual orientation and race.
- (C) Non-civil service vacancies are not posts on the civil service establishment. Candidates appointed are not on civil service terms of appointment and conditions of service. Candidates appointed are not civil servants and will not be eligible for posting, promotion or transfer to any posts in the Civil Service.
- (D) The entry pay, terms of appointment and conditions of service to be offered are subject to the provisions prevailing at the time the offer of appointment is made.
- (E) Where a large number of candidates meet the specified entry requirements, the recruiting department may devise shortlisting criteria to select the better qualified candidates for further processing. In these circumstances, only shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend recruitment examination and/or interview.
- (F) It is Government policy to place people with a disability in appropriate jobs wherever possible. If a disabled candidate meets the entry requirements, he/she will be invited to attend the selection interview/written examination without being subject to any further shortlisting criteria.
- (G) Holders of academic qualifications other than those obtained from Hong Kong institutions/Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority may also apply but their qualifications will be subject to assessments on equivalence with the required entry qualifications. They should submit copies of their official transcripts and certificates by mail to the above enquiry address.
